

COOUNTING BANK

A practical way to learn counting money.



Supplies:
1 die
Pennies
Nickels
Dimes
Quarters
Half-dollars
Dollar bills



Objective: to count money up to the next coin amount and cash in/exchange it for that coin, until one player reaches a dollar bill.

Example Play: Player 1's roll achieves a 4, and collects 4 pennies. The next player rolls and collects their coins. Player 1 rolls again and achieves a 3, and collects their three pennies. At this point, they have 7 pennies. Because 5 pennies make a nickel, they exchange five pennies for a nickel. They still have 7 cents. The game continues in this manner, cashing in pennies for nickels, nickels for dimes, dimes and nickels for quarters, and so on. The first person to get to a dollar bill, wins.
