Suggested Game Prep:

• Print game cards on cardstock and laminate for extended use.

Suggested Use:

- Give game cards to students. (Two provided, but you could edit to make additional cards)
- Provide students with dry beans, macaroni noodles, or Bingo Dotter to mark their cards.
- Randomly call out words from the Call Word List. Traditional Bingo uses the call letters at the top of each column, but for the purpose of this game, word identification is more suitable than grid-work.
- *To win*: the first student to get five in a row (either horizontally, vertically, or diagonally).
- Variations: First student to get all four corners, an X, or a Diamond shape.
