Directions: Choose one of the following National Symbols. Create a mini-book using materials in the classroom to list facts about the symbol.

National Symbols
Air Force One
The Jefferson Monument
The Liberty Bell
The Lincoln Monument

The Statue of Liberty
The US Flag
The White House
WWI Monument

Your mini-book should contain the following:

- A Title
- 2 illustrations (one should be of the symbol)
- 4 facts about the symbol
- Where the symbol is located
- How many people visit the symbol each year (you'll need to get online to find this)
- Why it is a national symbol

It should also:

- Be neat!
- Words should be spelled correctly
- Sentences should begin with a capital letter
- Sentences should end with a punctuation mark
- Contain no stray marks or scribbles
- Show your attention to detail (This means do NOT rush)

You might write about the following:

1. When was it built?
2. Who made it?
3. Where did it come from?
4. Who is it named after?
5. What does it represent?

You may add additional information, but the mini-book must include the information listed above.
